Frog Peak Music (2001)

This piece was written for solo electric guitar with the intention that the performer would have access to several devices: 1) a looping device – analog or digital – that can record at least eleven seconds of music, and layer at least 6 of these loops together; 2) a reverb that can create a "cavernous" sound, with a decay of at least 15 seconds; 3) a volume pedal; 4) an e-bow and 5) a slide.

There are three loops that must be recorded and performed in real time. When the score calls for the loops to begin, the player should play/record part 1 of the loop. When finished with part 1, the loop should repeat as noted before the player adds the next part.

The entire work should be performed with a large room sound.

Terms and performance notes.

Quarter tones = played by bending the note (except where noted to use slide)

Accidentals last throughout the measure, including quarter tones.

(Measure numbers do not include loops)
